

The Australian Immunisation Register (AIR)

Register as a vaccination provider

Apply to become a vaccination provider on the Australian Immunisation Register.

Medical practitioner, midwife or nurse practitioner with a Medicare provider number.

If you're a medical practitioner, midwife or nurse practitioner with a Medicare provider number, you're both:

- an automatically recognised vaccination provider
- authorised to record or get immunisation data on the AIR.

Medical practice, pharmacy*, organisation or Authorised Nurse Immuniser**

Complete and submit the **Australian Immunisation register - Application to register as a vaccination provider form (IM004)**.



Note: If an organisation/business has multiple sites that provide a vaccination service, each site must submit a separate application.

Follow the instructions on the form to submit your application.

We'll send your AIR vaccination provider number in the mail.



We'll send your AIR linking code in a separate letter.

Next: Follow the registration process in your letter.



* Pharmacists can't apply as an individual applicant. They must apply as an organisation applicant on behalf of their pharmacy.

** Authorised Nurse Immunisers (ANIs) without an ABN can't register for their own AIR provider number. In this case, to report vaccines to AIR, they should use the AIR provider number of the organisation that employs them or a health professional who has delegated access.

Note: AIR provider numbers are **not transferable**. Where a business changes ownership and/or business structure, a new AIR provider number must be applied for by the new owner.
