


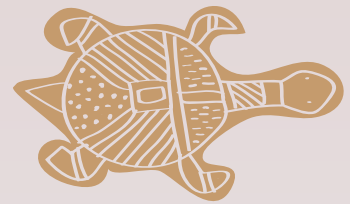
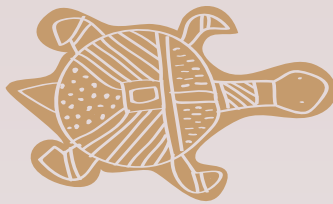
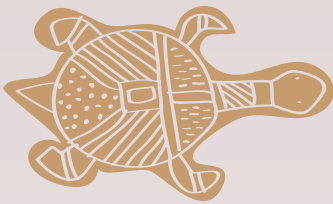


Indigenous Health Incentive Registration






The Indigenous Health Incentive targets Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander patients aged 15 years and over, with a chronic disease.

Some things to note before registration.

-  Your patient has had or been offered an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health assessment.
-  This is the patient's usual practice.
-  Re-register patients annually for the Indigenous Health Incentive.



Use your PRODA account to register your patients for the Indigenous Health Incentive using PIP Online through HPOS.

-  Check your patient's eligibility.
-  Discuss the Indigenous Health Incentive with your patient.
-  Seek consent to register your eligible patient.
-  Complete patient registration and consent form and submit to us.
-  Use your recall system to ensure patients are followed up.
