In a calendar year, Medicare benefits are available to a maximum of:

- 5 individual CDM allied health services
- 10 individual follow-up allied health services.

Case conference services

A case conference must be organised by a patient's treating General Practitioner (GP) and involve at least 3 healthcare professionals. The patient must agree to the Podiatrist participating in the case conference.

* These items have a limit of one per 3 month period, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

*Case conference participation - CDM allied health	10955	At least 15 but less than 20 minutes
	10957	At least 20 but less than 40 minutes
	10959	At least 40 minutes
